

## Student Scholarships Now Available!

The University of Washington Herbarium, Burke Museum, and University of Washington Botanic Gardens are offering ten scholarships for current, full-time students to attend the [2019 Washington Botanical Symposium](#) at no charge.

Priority will be given to students who will bring a poster to present on current botanical work or research.

To be considered for a scholarship, email [urbhort@uw.edu](mailto:urbhort@uw.edu), by 5:00pm, February 6, 2019, sending the following:

- **One to two paragraphs about your interest in the symposium**
- **A picture/copy of your current student ID**
- **Indicate whether you will bring a poster and if so, provide the poster title**

Applications will be considered starting February 7, and applicants will be notified of their scholarship status by February 20.

If you are a student who has already registered for the symposium, you may still apply for a scholarship. If you receive a scholarship, your registration fee will be refunded.

### Washington Botanical Symposium Poster Session Information

- A poster session will run concurrently with the symposium in the NHS Hall, and attendees will have the opportunity to visit with poster presenters at lunch and break times.
- Presenters must indicate at the time of registration if they intend to bring a poster. Space is limited and poster presenters must be pre-registered.
- Size of poster should be limited to a maximum of 4 x 3 feet (48 x 36 inches).
- One 48" by 36" board and an easel will be provided for each poster presentation.
- Text, graphs, and tables contained on the poster should be easily read from a distance of 6 feet. Titles and headings should be large and readable from a greater distance.
- Poster stands and boards will be set up at 8:15am. Authors are welcome to bring their posters at this time to place posters on poster board (clips and tape will be provided).
