COVID-19 Prevention

We have now spent more than a year consulting with Public Health professionals and agencies to learn about the virus itself and have adhered to all changes in recommendations for operation, specifically in childcare programs. We are adhering to those [guidelines laid out by the Washington Department of Health](#) for childcare with additional support and ideas for the Center for Disease Control's ["Suggestions for Youth and Summer Camps"](#) and additional, King County-specific resources. The UW Department of Environmental Health and Safety will review and approve our health and safety plan for the internship program prior to the program start date. Just a few of the many precautions in place this year:

- Daily staff and intern health screenings
- Thorough disinfection of surfaces, restrooms, and materials
- No sharing of materials without thorough disinfection
- Consistent hand sanitization and hand washing throughout the day
- Interns and staff wearing face coverings at all times—this excludes when eating or drinking when adequate spacing will be maintained
- Group sizes of 15 people total or less

Policies and procedures may change as safety requirements from the University of Washington and the Washington Department of Health change.
