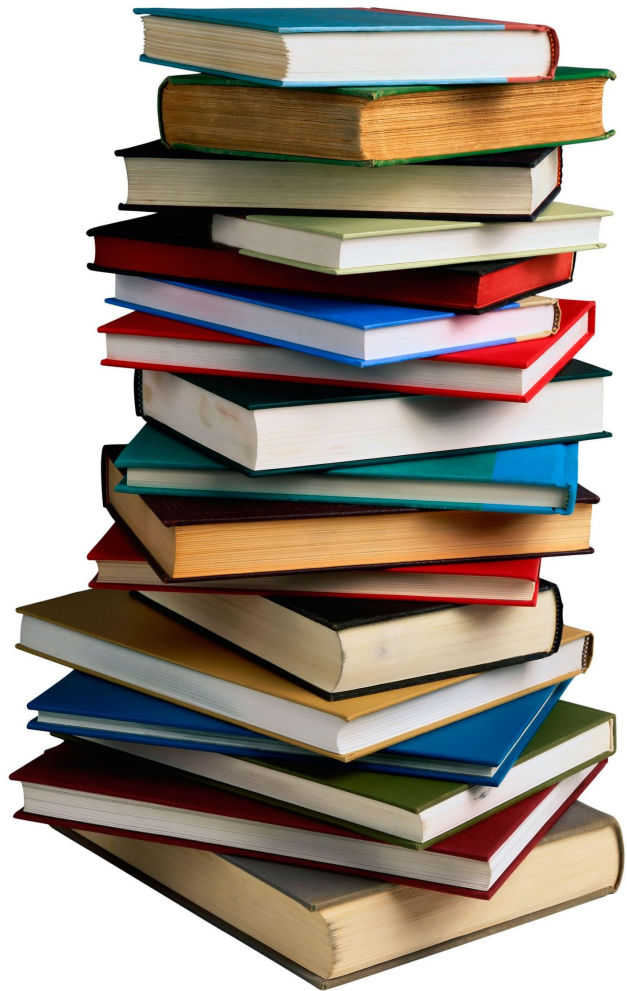

# Disability Access Observations

- With our current observations of the UW Farm Mercer Court there is no disability access to any of the beds.
- Each of the 3 sections are two terraces separated by stairs.
- All lower terraces have gravel paths which means no wheelchair access and very limited access to those with other mobility issues.



# Disability Access Findings

- During our Lit review we found that for a garden to be considered a community garden with Disability access it must meet the following specifications.
  - At least one bed must be 24” to 30” in Height and 48” in Width
  - The paths must have a turn around width must be at least 60”
